The Spiritual Labyrinth is user friendly with paths that are three feet wide and a circle in the center in which to meditate and rest. More than one can walk the path at one time. All are welcome to also visit the prayer garden, located next to the labyrinth.

A Spiritual Labyrinth is used in many ways. It is basically a meditative path to follow, a place to use for spiritual ceremonies, and a place for children to explore. The Spiritual Labyrinth is designed to help the user focus their thought. Not to be confused with a maze that has many directions and mistaken pathways, a labyrinth has only one path in and one path out. We invite you to experience the journey by yourself, with a friend or with a group. All are welcome to come and experience this closeness with God.
