Instructions for Scholarship Application

The form on the reverse side is for your use in submitting the requested information to the Scholarship Committee of Elma United Methodist Church. All information will be kept confidential. This application form and all other requested materials are to be returned no later than May 15th, 2021 to Elma UMC Scholarship Committee at the church address listed above. Scholarships are not guaranteed and will be awarded based on the qualifications listed below. In the past there have been scholarships available through the denomination. Please check their website to see if those are available to you in the future. This application is only for scholarships awarded by the Elma UMC scholarship committee.

Requirements for Scholarship:

(Please read carefully prior to completing application. If you do not meet the criteria, your application will not be considered.)

- 1. The applicant <u>must be</u> an active member or constituent (attending non-member) of Elma United Methodist Church for at least a period of six months, or active in other religious activities while at your place of higher education.
- 2. The applicant <u>must be</u> accepted in an accredited two or four year undergraduate college/university, or an accredited program for types of vocational certification.
- 3. The application <u>must</u> maintain an academic average of C or better to qualify for the initial or any additional scholarship.
- 4. All information **must be** received by the church office by the dead line indicated.
- 5. All applications <u>must be</u> completely filled out and all required sections <u>must be</u> present.
- 6. Scholarships are awarded yearly, for a <u>maximum of four years</u>. The four years need not be sequential.

Transcript:

A transcript <u>must be</u> submitted with this application. This need not be a purchased "official" transcript

References:

One letter of reference, excluding members of the Scholarship Committee and relatives, is required and <u>must</u> <u>be</u> submitted with your application. (Reference letters may be mailed separately, but **must** arrive by the dead-line.) Reference letters <u>must be dated and current</u>. The applicant is **required** to seek a letter from teachers or staff at their school who know them.

The <u>Student</u> is responsible for ensuring all required information, including supporting material, is received in the office <u>on time</u>. Forms may be delivered by hand, mailed, faxed or emailed, but MUST all be received in the office on or before the deadline.

<u>Deadline</u> for submission of application and all supporting materials: Saturday, May 15th, 2021.

Note: If you are requesting your scholarship check be sent directly to your school, this information **MUST be included with your application**, including any required paperwork for matching funds. It is the **student's responsibility** to provide this information, not the Church's.
